## GSCC Dual Enrollment Guidelines

- 1. You must complete a Dual Enrollment Form (available in Guidance Office).
- 2. You must apply to GSCC and be accepted. You may do this online at gadsdenstate.edu. However, if you do this online you must either print the signature page and take it to GSCC with a picture ID (it cannot be mailed). If you have any questions, call GSCC Admissions Office at (256)549-8210.

## 3. Test Scores

- a. If you have already taken the ACT, you must have a score of 20 on the English portion or a 23 on the math portion. Gadsden State will need a copy at the time you enroll to place on file.
- b. If you did not score high enough on the ACT, you will need to take a placement test at GSCC. The number for setting up the placement test is (256)549-8210. They usually give it from 8:00am-1:00pm (Monday-Thursday) at Allen Hall. Placement tests should be taken during the summer. You are allowed to take the exam twice (first time in free, second time is \$8).

## 4. Approval

a. You must take your approved Dual Enrollment Form to GSCC to register for the class (you cannot register online). Just to be safe, I would take a copy of your ACT/Placement scores with you at time of registration. You must pay your tuition when you register. If you have any questions, call the GSCC Registrar's Office at (256)549-8259. Registration for fall semester begins July 2014 and classes begin in August.

## 5. Course Cost

- a. Tuition must be paid the same day that student registers for course. (Financial Aid is NOT available for Dual Enrollment)
- b. Current cost: (could increase over the summer)
  - i. \$126 per hour x 3 hour credit course= \$378 per semester(Subject to Change)

## 6. 2<sup>nd</sup> semester

a. You will be responsible for making sure that Dual Enrollment paper work is approved for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (2<sup>nd</sup>).

Eligible students are permitted to enroll in college courses conducted during school hours, after school hours and during summer terms. Courses offered shall be drawn from Gadsden State's existing academic inventory of courses for credit. Courses numbered below 100 and physical education courses are not eligible under this plan. Gadsden State reserves the right to cancel course offerings when courses do not meet minimum enrollment requirements. Students attending a non-accredited high must show documentation of a minimum score of 16 on ACT or 790 on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) to enroll in degree creditable courses.

#### To be eligible for DUAL enrollment each student must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Meet the entrance requirements established by Gadsden State for dual enrollment;
- 2. Have a "B" average in completed high school courses;

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- 3. Have written approval of the appropriate principal and local superintendent of education;
- Be in grades 10, 11, or 12 grade or have an exception granted by Gadsden State upon the recommendation of the student's principal and superintendent and in accordance with the Alabama Administrative Code 290-8.9.17 regarding gifted and talented students;
- 5. Students who are enrolled in grades 10, 11, or 12 may be deemed eligible to participate in dual credit/dual enrollment in occupational/technical courses pending demonstrated "ability to benefit" as documented by successful completion of Compass, which is approved by the Department of Postsecondary Education. Students enrolled under the "ability to benefit" provision must have a "B" (3.0 grade point average) in high school courses directly related to occupational/technical studies (if applicable) which the student intends to pursue at the postsecondary level and an overall 2.5 grade point average in high course work. Exceptions may be made on individual student basis after assessment and with mutual consent of both the School Board and the College. Students who score 480 or above on the SAT verbal or at least a 20 on the ACT English will be exempt from the writing and reading portions of the exam. Students who score 480 or above on the SAT math or at least a 20 on the ACT math will be exempt from the math portion of the exam. An ACT math score of 20 or SAT math score of 480+ will be required for placement in MTH 100. An ACT math score of 23 or SAT math score of 540+ will be required for placement in MTH 110.

Students with disabilities who may require special accommodations should notify their instructors of such needs 6 weeks prior to the first week of classes each semester. Appropriate documentation of such disabilities must be filed with Disability Compliance Officer before accommodations will be made.
