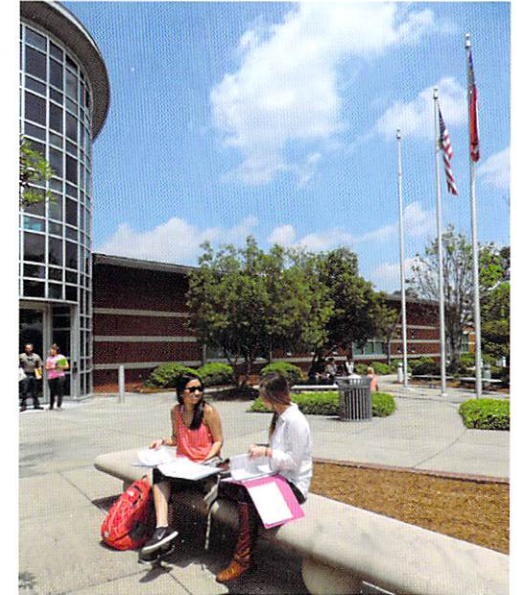

# HELPFUL FINANCIAL AID TIPS

- 1 No financial aid can be awarded until you've been accepted to ABAC.
- 2 Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). The deadline for fall semester is July 1 and for spring is November 15.
- 3 FAFSA results determine your eligibility for grants and loans. Apply as soon as you complete your tax return for the previous year. Prepare your taxes early!
- 4 If you are a Georgia resident eligible for the HOPE Scholarship, you must go through the financial aid process.
- 5 Access your eStallion and ABAC email account and confirm the office has received all necessary information.

## Scholarship Information

To be considered for ABAC academic scholarships, you must complete the admissions process and submit the scholarship application by March 1.

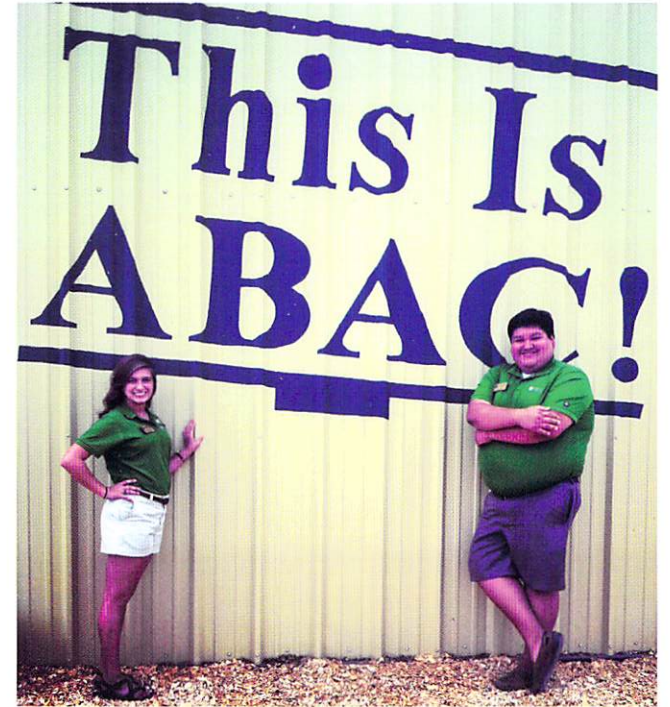
