- There are over 82,000 operations in the U.S., a majority of them family owned and operated.

- Because of the diversity in geography, climate and management systems used in sheep husbandry, lambing seasons vary considerably. The goal is to raise succulent, tender meat with spring-lamb flavor any time of year.
- While many producers have small farm flocks between 50-300 animals, others have large operations ranging from 1,000 to 10,000 sheep.
- American sheep are raised for meat and wool with more than 40 breeds of sheep raised in the United States.
