CRITERIA FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) The applicant must be a graduating senior who has earned one athletic letter their senior year.
- 2) The applicant must have maintained a 75 grade point average from the 9th grade to the end of the first semester of the 12th grade.
- 3) The applicant must have taken the ACT prior to the end of the first semester of the 12th grade.
- 4) The applicant must attend a post secondary school and the scholarship must be used by Sept. 30th of the year it is received.
- 5) The applicant must sign a disclaimer that they have not been involved in any criminal or immoral acts.
- 6) There will be a scoring system (270 points) to determine the winner of the scholarship.
 - A) Grade Point Average (100 points possible)
 - B) Coaches Opinion (28 points possible)
 - C) Classes – Only one non-academic class counted per year.
(Honor, Advance and AP courses – 2 points possible)
Regular classes – 1 point possible
 - D) Participation- 1 point will be given for each sport he/she has participated in from the 9th-12th grade.
 - E) Athletic Letter- 1 point will be given for each sport he/she has received a letter from the 9th-12th grade.
 - F) Act Score- Your cumulative score will be used.
