## ▶ CHANCELLOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

**Award is \$32,000 - annual value \$8,000**

Requires minimum 28 ACT score (1260 SAT) and a minimum 3.5 high school grade-point average

This scholarship requires a separate application available at [www.aum.edu/scholarships](http://www.aum.edu/scholarships)

## ▶ WARHAWK SCHOLARSHIP

**Award is \$16,000 - annual value \$4,000**

Requires a minimum 25 ACT score (1150 SAT) and minimum GPA of 3.0

## ▶ ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

**Award is \$8,000 - annual value \$2,000**

Requires a minimum 23 ACT score (1070 SAT) and a minimum GPA of 3.0

## ▶ RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP

**Award is \$4,000 - annual value \$1,000**

Requires a minimum 20 ACT score (950 SAT) and minimum GPA of 3.5

### THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Freshman Scholarship priority is given to students admitted by March 1.
- The application for admission serves as the application for Freshman Scholarships. A separate application is only required for the Chancellor's Scholarship.
- Minimum academic requirements for scholarship consideration are for first-time, full-time freshmen entering AUM in Fall 2014 directly from high school. Scholarships are subject to change for enrollment in future terms.
- All awards are renewable and amounts are per academic year (Fall and Spring terms).

# FINANCIAL AID

## APPLICATION PROCESS



### Know the FAFSA priority filing deadline

Auburn Montgomery has a priority deadline of March 1 each year. This means the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be received by the Federal Processor on or before March 1. Please note that an electronic submission may take 2-5 business days to reach the Federal Processor. For priority consideration, you'll want to file at least a week prior to March 1.

### Apply for a PIN

Request a PIN by visiting [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). If you are a dependent student, your parents should also request a PIN as they will need to sign your FAFSA as well.

### Gather financial information

Gather income and asset information, federal tax returns, etc. for the year prior to the FAFSA award year. For example, if you are filling out the FAFSA for the 2014-2015 academic year, you will need information from your 2013 federal income tax return(s), W-2(s), etc. You will also need to list Auburn Montgomery's Title IV school code (008310) on the FAFSA to have your information released to this institution.

### Submit FAFSA

Go to [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) to complete your FAFSA online. Make sure that you electronically sign your application with your PIN. If you are a dependent student, make sure that one of your parents sign with their PIN as well.

### Check your AUM email account often

Your AUM email account is the official mode of communication for the university. Upon acceptance to AUM, you will be assigned an AUM e-mail. Be sure to check your email account on a regular basis. If additional information or documentation is needed once you have submitted your FAFSA, an email request will be sent to you.

### Aid package will be awarded

The Auburn Montgomery Financial Aid Office will create an award package and you will be notified of your eligibility. Your aid package will be based on the information provided on the FAFSA, as well as institutional information. An award information email will be sent once you have been awarded. You may also check your Webster account for your award information.
