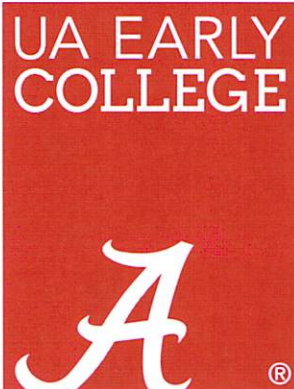

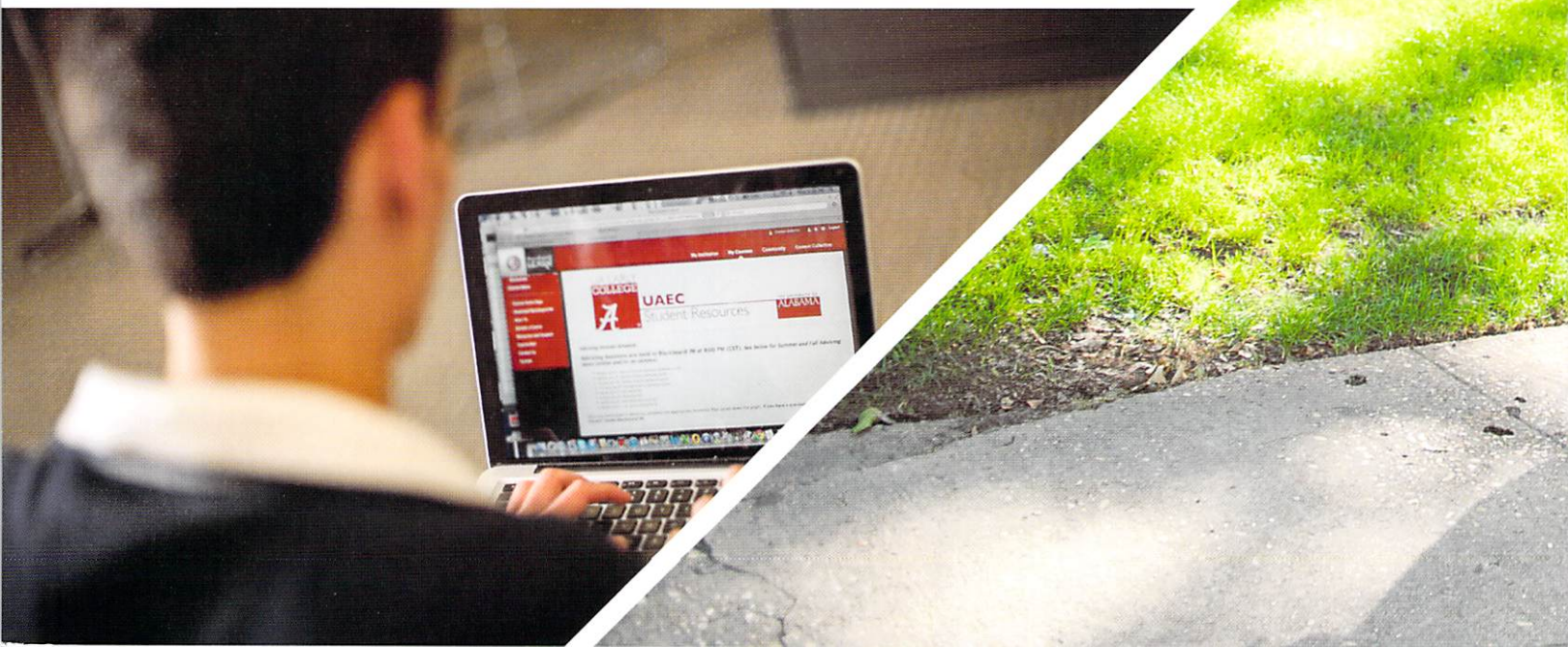

## Why Choose UA Early College?

- ▶ You earn up to 30 hours of college credit, online or on campus.
- ▶ You choose flexible course options, online 24/7 or on campus during the summer.
- ▶ You may be eligible for UA Early College partial tuition scholarships. Contact [earlycollege@ua.edu](mailto:earlycollege@ua.edu).
- ▶ You will use vibrant technology that includes videos, Web conference, Wiki, podcasts and discussion boards.
- ▶ You enter The University of Alabama as a freshman, still eligible for freshman scholarships and Honors College, even if you have Advanced Placement credit.
- ▶ You are eligible for UA admission without submitting SAT or ACT scores if you earn at least 17 hours of credit and a 2.5-plus GPA through Early College.
- ▶ Your credit transfers to most colleges nationwide.

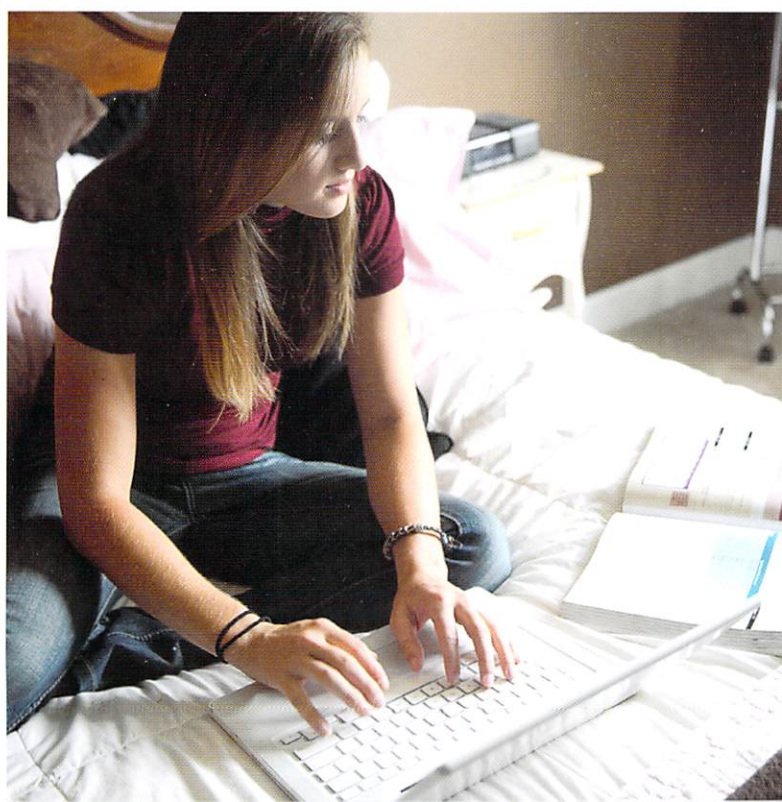
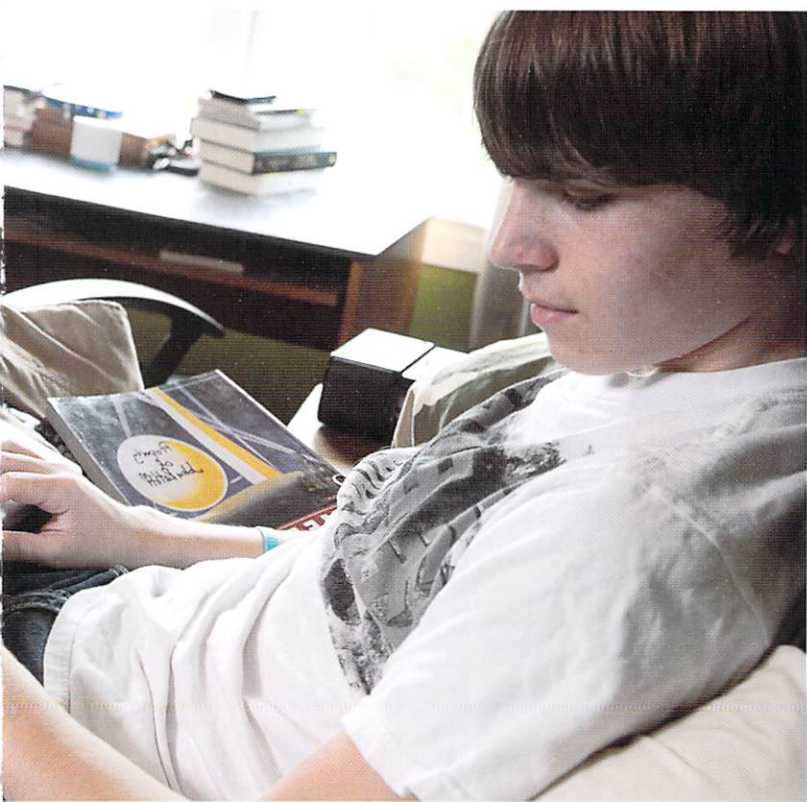

## What Are the Requirements?

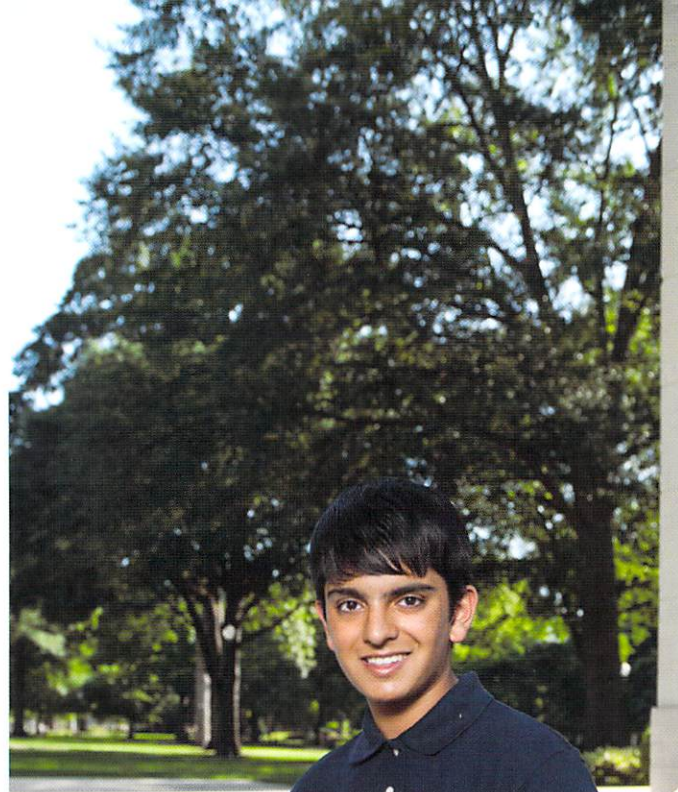
- » You have a cumulative 3.0 or higher GPA in high school since the ninth grade.
