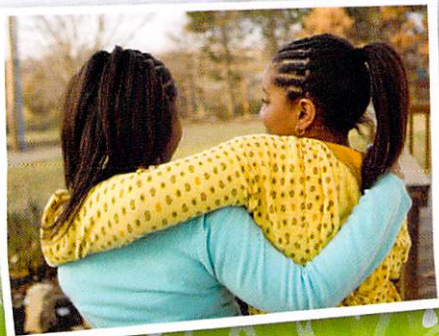
# Camp I Believe is a place for kids to...

# Play

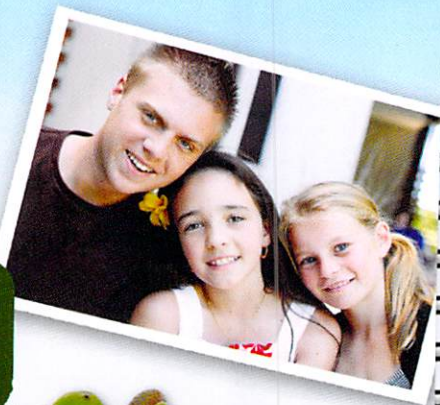

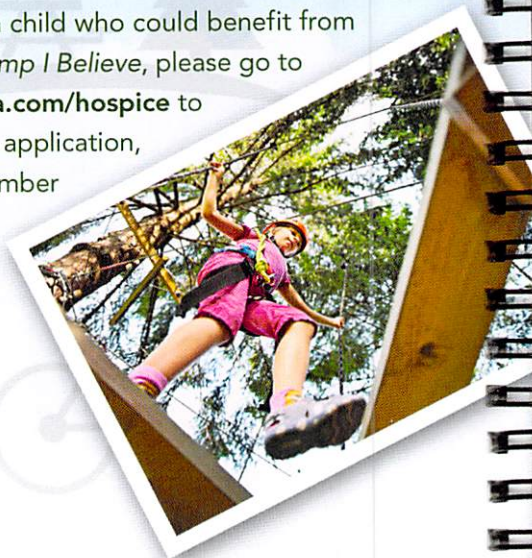
## Camp I Believe is for children ages 7-14 who...
