The Rural Scholars Program from the University of Alabama will host the *Rural Minority Health Scholars Program* (RMHSP) for the 12<sup>th</sup> year. Ten graduating seniors from across rural Alabama will have an opportunity participate in the program this summer. The ultimate goal of this program is to encourage students from rural areas to prepare for careers in the health professions. It is hoped that these students will return to rural communities as physicians, pharmacists, dentist, technicians, and other health professionals. Because we are confident you share an interest in this goal, and you are also interested in students from your community having maximum opportunities to work toward their personal goals, we are asking your help in identifying prospective participants for the 2016 program.

The purpose of this program is to give students from rural backgrounds that have an interest in the health care profession a head start in the college preparation they will need for admissions to professional programs. Participants will take one college course for credit and attend a seminar designed to help them succeed in college. We hope to encourage these students to retain an interest in the health care profession throughout their undergraduate enrollment, and to enhance their prospects for achieving competitive qualifications for entering professions and professional schools. Studies show that students with rural backgrounds are the most likely persons to return to rural communities after their post-high school training.

With you and others in rural communities helping us get the word to prospective students, we are confident we can identify and attract qualified students to these summer program. An application packet is enclosed. We hope you will give it to a student who might be well served by this program. (If additional applications are needed, please feel free to reproduce the forms or have prospects contact us directly. **Applications should be postmarked by March 1.** 

In talking to a prospect, please point out that all expenses are covered. (Tuition, housing, books and that each person will be provided \$500 for a meal ticket). Dates for the program are May 29-June 29 with an orientation on Sunday, May 29. We look forward to receiving the application of the students you select whom you think will be a great candidate for this program.

- 1. Complete all sections of the attached application form. *Please print*.
- 2. **Two letters** of recommendations are required. Have two of the following persons to submit a recommendation for you:
  - Math, Science or English Teacher
  - Guidance Counselor
  - Principal or someone familiar with your academic performance.

The letters of recommendation should include their professional judgment of your prospects for being successful in a college environment.

3. Have your high school counselor submit a copy of your high school transcript, including scores on any ACT or SAT exams you have taken.

NOTE: YOU ARE ADMISSIBLE TO THE PROGRAM IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY IN THE 12TH GRADE AND HAVE TAKEN THE ACT AND EARNED A SCORE OF 22 OR SAT AND EARNED A SCORE OF 1000. THE HIGHER YOUR ACT OR SAT THE MORE COMPETITIVE YOU ARE.

- 4. **ESSAYS REQUIRED:** Please write three short essays answering the following questions.
  - 1. Why would I like to participate in the Rural Minority Health Scholars Program?
  - 2. What type of health care professional you would like to be and why?
  - 3. Why do I consider myself rural?

Please type your answers and limit them to one page each.

- 5. It is your responsibility to make sure your application and recommendations have been submitted on time with all the necessary materials. Make sure your name and the name of the person providing the recommendation is clearly printed on the recommendation.
- 6. All materials (including application, test scores, and recommendations) should be in one envelope and be postmarked on or before March 1. Mail to:
