Description/Requirements
High school juniors and seniors and students currently enrolled in any accredited post secondary institution
Students pursuing a degree in the college of business or a degree in k-12 education from an Alabama college or university
Enrolling in an Alabama college, university or technical school with a construction related curriculum
Enrolling in an Alabama college or university with a civil engineer curriculum
Based on academic excellence, volunteer and work experience
HS Senior or attending a post secondary institute and currently involved in some sport at that institute or in the community
Accepted to a NAAB-accredited architecture program; Graphic work and an essay
High School Senior
Academic merit - usually top 1-2% of applicants
Usually in the top 10% in class; active leaders in school and community
1st time freshman; major in one of the following: science, technology, engineering, math, business admin., finance, marketing or design; interested in the automotive or related industry
Minimum GPA of 2.4 and financial need; must work part-time at least 10 hours a week; community service
Junior in high school; top 5% of their class; taking strong college prep curriculum; minimum 1250 SAT (PSAT 125) score; minimum 28 ACT(PLAN26) score; school, community or religious participation
Minimum 3.0 GPA; motivated, dedicated and involved students
Not a beauty pageant but rather a scholarship program that rewards overall excellence. Details are given at the orientation meeting on March 16th.

Must be an eCO member in good standing; planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college
Must be a paid member of Alabama FBLA, a graduating senior and be able to attend the Alabama FBLA Conference.
Non-Michigan residents enrolling in College of Engineering
Must submit an essay and have a minimum GPA of 2.5
Participated in varsity athletics; accepted to 4 year Alabama college or university
Must exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the US
Plan to attend Jeff State; minimum 3.0 and ACT score of 22; essay and recommendation required
MBHS can nominate on student who plans to attend Jeff State
Leadership skills and academic success; host or hostess for community and college sponsored events
At least a 2.5 GPA and outstanding work ethic
Acceptance to Jeff State; full-time student; maintaining a 2.5 GPA; taking a basic musicianship (music notation) course; audition required
For students whose parents have died or become permanently disabled in an on-the-job accident
A student who is making a difference in the community through volunteering
Alabama women with financial need; sound academic record; 4 year Alabama college or university; minimum ACT 23
Not based on grades or honors, only on essay
Students interested in Mercer's engineering program should come to the counseling office
Minimum 13 years of age, may not have graduated from high school before finals, may not turn 18 before 7/31 of year in which competing in finals
ACT score of 28, SAT score of 1250, GPA 3.5 or higher

Must have minimum GPA of 3.5, submit and essay and be accepted to one of the following schools: Drexel University, Kettering University, Pace University, University of Cincinnati, Wentworth Institute of Technology, University of Toledo, Rochester Institute of Technology and Johnson and Wales University.

Scholarship based on candidate interest and evaluation results and upon the recommendation from the scholarship committee

Minimum GPA of 2.5 in last academic year and at least 50 hours of volunteer service within the community

High school sophomore, junior or senior, minimum "C" average, currently a varsity level athlete in one or more sports, committed follower of Jesus Christ.

Scholarship awards are based on community service / volunteerism

Will be attending Samford; applicant with a background in athletics, band, cheerleading or dance

Minimum 27 ACT or 1220 SAT; Minimum 3.75 GPA; outstanding visual arts, performing arts, writing talent or riding skills; honors and awards; leadership skills

AL Senior, C+ GPA, planning to attend a four year public college in Alabama or nursing accredited two year institution; significant contribution to family or community; must have taken the ACT

Demonstrates excellent leadership; rank 25% of graduating class; minimum ACT 28 or 1230 SAT; essay required

MBHS can nominate one entry for this contest, and it will be judged by the Honors College at the University of Alabama

General to specific scholarships available for incoming freshman to Troy University

Based upon the quality of the student's work and contingent upon admission to The University of Alabama

No separate application needed; Information is taken from school application
Intends to attend University of Montevallo; submits a poem no more than 100 lines long
Average of 6 scholarships are awarded each year based on the students' talent, potential and academic achievement
Received an honors high school diploma; minimum composite 29 ACT score; begins a general studies in computer and information science
Young women are selected for their computing and IT aptitude, leadership ability, academic history and plans for post secondary education
Top 10% of class; 1250 SAT or 28 on ACT/PLAN; Leadership qualities
Need to be a graduating high school senior who is entering his or her freshman year at an accredited two or four year college or vocational institute and who owns/operates an established business
Community/school service; having excelled despite some sort of extreme adversity
Must have completed a minimum of 50 hours volunteer work and maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or greater over the past 2 years.
