

**Guidelines for Awarding Sons of Confederate Veterans
Ten Island Camp 2678 Annual Scholarship**

- 1. Eligibility: To be eligible for consideration the applicant must be:**
 - A. A student or prospective student in an accredited junior college or four year college or university, which is a degree-granting institution.**
 - B. The student must have been a legal resident of Calhoun County, Alabama for at least one year.**

- 2. Amount of frequency of award:**
 - A. The amount of award is \$500.00 annually.**
 - B. Since the membership of The Ten Island Camp is comprised mainly of Ohatchee and Alexandria residents, the scholarship will be awarded to residents of these two communities on alternating school years. Note: Applicants are not limited to only these two high schools, but must be a resident in these districts.**
 - C. Awards shall be made on a one-time-per applicant basis and shall not be renewable for any subsequent year.**

- 3. Application Requirements:**
 - A. No application shall be considered unless all required documents are received.**
 - B. Applications must be received by April 24, 2015. You may either send by mail to: Sons of Confederate Veterans, 145 Janney Rd., Ohatchee, Alabama 36271 or left with Mr. Robert Lindley at the Civil War and Indian Museum at Janney Furnace.**

- 4. Selection and Notification:**
 - A. The selection committee will make its decision based on the application and associated documents.**
 - B. The scholarship selection committee will meet on April 26th, 2015. The selected candidate and school (if it is a high school student) will be notified within five days.**
