### PRESIDENTIAL MENTORS ACADEMY (PMA)

Student must be an Alabama resident

(or reside in one of the sixteen Mississippi and Tennessee counties considered by UNA to be "in-state")

Minimum 3.00 GPA on High School Unweighted GPA • Minimum ACT score of 18 • Activity résumé required

UNA supports opportunities for students whose racial group is underrepresented within its student body. In this spirit, the PMA provides learning experiences for incoming minority freshmen. The program combines an emphasis on academic success with financial assistance for students who qualify for participation. The successful candidate must possess both leadership potential and the potential to succeed in a higher education environment. Eligible students must apply for admission to the University and must submit both an activity résumé of high school activities and a letter of recommendation from a high school principal, counselor, or teacher on or before **December 15, 2016**.
