Greetings from the University of Montevallo. We hope you had a wonderful summer break! With the beginning of a new school year, we wanted to take the time to give you some information about the University of Montevallo.

Located in the center of Alabama, U.M. has been named a National Historic District and was designed by the Olmsted Brothers landscape architectural firm, with members of the same team that designed Central Park in New York City and the grounds at the Biltmore Estate. It is one of the most beautiful campuses you will ever step foot on!

With almost 3,000 currently enrolled undergraduate students, Montevallo maintains a 16 to 1 student to faculty ratio, and over 95% of the faculty holds the terminal degree for their discipline.

Montevallo was named a College of Distinction for 2016, earning this accolade for the third year in a row. In addition to its high academic standards, Montevallo also boasts over 90 student organizations and 17 NCAA Division II sports teams, meaning it is easier than ever for students to get involved in campus life.

First-year admission requirements are a 20 composite score on the ACT with a cumulative 2.5 GPA. With an ACT score of 23 or higher and a 3.0 GPA, students are eligible for UM's merit based scholarships.
